

Digital ID and KYC Utilities for Embracing the FinTech Era



The application of technology for facilitating the provision of financial services is gaining traction globally. During the development of FinTech infrastructure to enhance the KYC process, Hong Kong also needs urgent regulatory fixes to improve customers' account opening experience and, more importantly, to maintain the city's financial competitiveness.

The FSDC released a research report entitled the "Building the Technological and Regulatory Infrastructure of a 21st Century International Financial Centre: Digital ID and KYC Utilities for Financial Inclusion, Integrity and Competitiveness" in June 2018. The report seeks to present the main features of an essential strategy to develop the necessary technological and regulatory infrastructure for digital identification and electronic-KYC in Hong Kong.

Our speakers will share with you their views on the infrastructure that Hong Kong would need for digital identification of customers in the non-face-to-face on-boarding context. They will also share their views on the necessary elements of a KYC utility to address various international financial regulations, with the longer-term goal of facilitating customers' investments decisions.
