The FSDC engages the industry and formulates proposals to promote its further development and map out the strategic direction for developing Hong Kong as an international financial centre.

Key Responsibilities:

- 1. To collect data and assist in conducting in-depth policy research and studies in relation to economic and financial market developments as well as human capital development;
- 2. Tap on different sources to maintain and update economic and financial database for the Policy Research team and generate data insights when necessary;
- 3. To assist in preparation of project plans, policy research papers, reports, speeches, presentation materials and briefing materials;
- To work closely with internal and external parties on research projects; to provide logistic support in organizing conferences and workshops as necessary;
- To provide administrative support to the Board of Directors, Committees and working groups on various policy issues and work initiatives of the FSDC; and
- 6. To perform any other duties as and when required.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent, preferably in finance, economics or related disciplines;
- 2. Preferably with 3 years' post-qualification experience in the financial services industry, with experiences in economic or financial market research and data analysis;
- 3. Meticulous and responsible with strong data analytical skills;
- 4. Keen interest and knowledge of the financial market;
- 5. Good writing and editorial skills in English and Chinese;
- 6. Fluent command of both spoken English and Chinese; good command of Putonghua;
- 7. Proficiency in computer knowledge and skills, including MS Office and Chinese word processing. Sound knowledge of economic and financial databases and analytical tools, such as Bloomberg and CEIC, is preferred; and
- 8. Ability to work effectively on multiple projects and to perform well under pressure to meet deadlines.
