The Financial Services Development Council ("FSDC") was established by the HKSAR Government in January 2013. The FSDC engages the financial services industry of Hong Kong and formulates proposals to promote the further development of the industry and map out the strategic direction for the development of Hong Kong as an international financial centre.

In September 2018, the FSDC was incorporated as a company limited by guarantee to better discharge its functions through research, market promotion, and human capital development with greater flexibility.

Key Responsibilities:

1. To collect data and assist in conducting in-depth policy research and studies in relation to economic and financial market developments as well as human capital development;
2. Tap on different sources to maintain and update the economic and financial database for the Policy Research team and generate data insights when necessary;
3. To support the development of project plans, policy research papers, and market reports, and prepare speeches, presentation materials and briefing materials;
4. To work closely with internal and external parties on research projects; to provide logistic support in organising conferences, roundtables and workshops as necessary;
5. To provide administrative support to the Board of Directors, Committees and working groups on various policy issues and work initiatives of the FSDC; and

6. To perform any other duties as and when required.

Requirements:

1. Bachelor's degree or equivalent, preferably in finance, economics or related disciplines;
2. Preferably with 3 years' post-qualification experience in the financial services industry, with experience in economic or financial market research and data analysis;
3. Meticulous and responsible with strong data analytical skills;
4. Keen interest and knowledge of the financial market;
5. Good writing and editorial skills in English and Chinese;
6. Fluent command of both spoken English and Chinese; good command of Putonghua;
7. Proficiency in computer knowledge and skills, including MS Office and Chinese word processing. Sound knowledge of economic and financial databases and analytical tools, such as Bloomberg and CEIC, is preferred; and
8. Ability to work effectively on multiple projects and to perform well under pressure to meet deadlines.
