Key Responsibilities

- 1. To assist in collecting information and compiling statistics for research projects and studies;

Requirements

- 1. Undergraduates, preferably in their penultimate year of study, or students enrolled in Master Degree courses, majoring in Finance or Business-related disciplines;

- 4. High proficiency in computer knowledge and skills, such as the use of MS Office and other research applications.
